**Issue # & Bill #**

#1 HB 2016 – This was a procedural vote challenging the “germaneness” of an Amendment that would bring about a debate and vote on Expanding Medicaid; A correct vote was to Oppose the ruling of the Chair (and thus allow debate) & consideration of the Amendm’t; **Oppose**

#2 HB 2016 – Curtis Amendm’t; This would provide protections for workers that contract COVID-19 by holding employers legally accountable when protections & safety against the virus were compromised putting the worker at risk; **Support**

#3 HB 2016 – Pittman Amendm’t; This provides for protections for workers under the Kansas Workers Compensation Program by allowing eligibility for benefits in COVID-19 related Disability or Death as a result of contracting the virus in the workplace; **Support**

#4 HB 2066 – Clayton Amendm’t; The COVID-19 related job loss has resulted in a dramatic downturn of economic activity in world leaving so many without a job to go to and provide for basic family necessities. Such “hardship” could be offset by this provision to prohibit for mortgage foreclosure due to the COVID-19 Pandemic; **Support**
